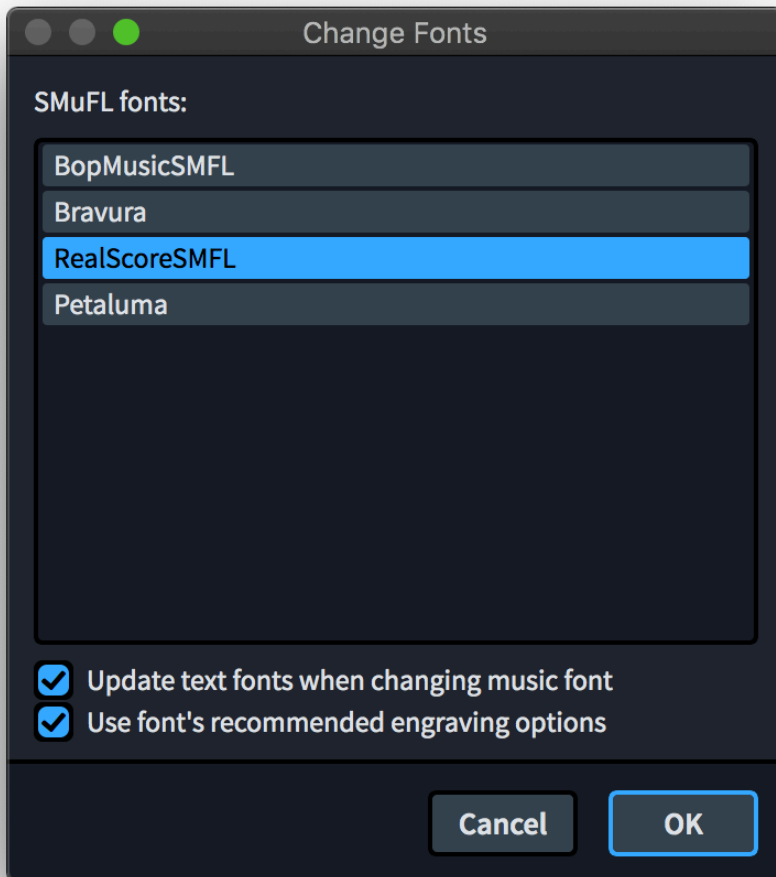


# APPLYING REALSCORE FONTS IN DORICO™ PRO

When running Dorico, it will find the new metadata file and will make an entry for the font in its list of available music fonts. However, to use the RealScoreSMFL font:



- Open a Dorico score,
- Go to **Engrave** mode (Ctrl+3 or Cmd+3), click on the **Engrave > Music Font** menu option,
- In the dialog window that appears, click on the name of the font in the list, then click the button "**Change Music Font**" select RealScoreSMFL to apply the font to your open score project;

You can optionally check or uncheck the box to use the recommended engraving options; click "**OK**", you'll notice that your score project is taking effect of the changes with the newly selected RealScoreSMFL font.

You might also want to change

the '**Default text**' style in **Engrave > Paragraph Styles** but also the '**Default text font**' font style in **Engrave > Font Styles** to RealScore Alpha font and **Engrave > Character Styles** set **Music Text** to RealScoreSMFL Text font.

# MAKING ENCLOSED, UNDERLINED, AND OVERLINED TEXT IN DORICO



You can apply Enclosed, Underlined, or Overlined Texts to your scores, by selecting **REALSCORE ALPHA ENCLOSURE** font or **REALSCORE ALPHA ENCLOSURE HEAVY** font.

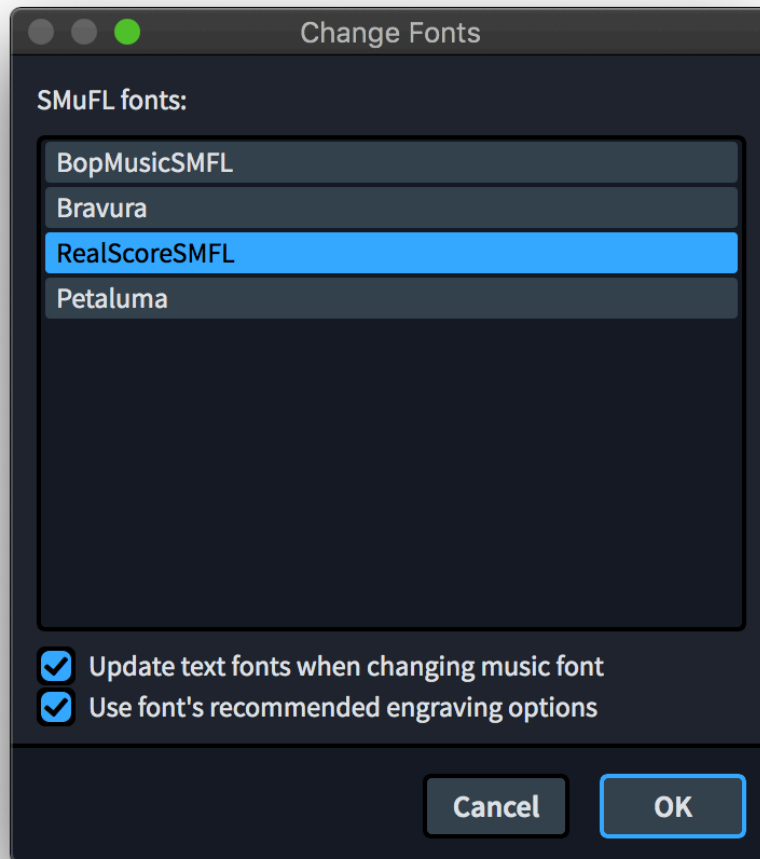
Let's type for example this text:

<i>{ Repeat ad lib. and fade } activate (u) &amp; (o)</i>	<b>REPEAT AD LIB. AND FADE</b>
<i>( Repeat ad lib. and fade ) activate (u) &amp; (o)</i>	<b>REPEAT AD LIB. AND FADE</b>
<i>( Repeat ad lib. and fade ) activate (u) only</i>	<b>REPEAT AD LIB. AND FADE</b>
<i>( Repeat ad lib. and fade ) activate (o) only</i>	<b>REPEAT AD LIB. AND FADE</b>

*...et voilà!*
