Notation Express User Guide - Sibelius



Congratulations on purchasing Notation Express, the fastest way to use Sibelius! Before we get going, here's some Q & A about what you are and aren't allowed to do.

License Q & A

Can I use Notation Express on more than one computer?

Yes! A purchase entitles one person (you) to use it on one computer at a time, on as many computers that you personally use. Unless you have extra limbs, that should suffice nicely.

Can I use Notation Express on both the Stream Deck console and the iOS app?

Yes! Your purchase entitles you to use Notation Express on both devices. You must purchase the Stream Deck console and subscribe to the Stream Deck Mobile iOS app separately.

Can my buddy who shares my computer use Notation Express?

No! Well, there's no way to technically prevent it. But please ask your buddy to purchase his own copy.

My buddy wants to use my copy of Notation Express. Can I send it to him?

No! He should purchase his own copy. Let's all be buddies!

OK. Can I change the default Notation Express profile — move icons around, add my own shortcuts, actions, etc.?

Yes! That's the beauty of it — it's totally customizable for your own use. You can change it straight away or keep the original handy and duplicate it for your own use. If you need to, you can always re-import the default Notation Express profile again.

So, once I do that, can I send that profile to my buddy?

No! Please don't share any profile derived from the Notation Express profile, unless your buddy has already purchased Notation Express, too — then it's OK.

Now that we're all clear on that, it's time to set up Notation Express!

Notation Express and Notation Express XL

This documentation guide refers both to the "original" version of Notation Express and Notation Express XL.

The original version of Notation Express uses a 5x3 grid and is designed to work with the Stream Deck console and the Stream Deck Mobile app for iOS and Android devices.

Notation Express XL uses an 8x4 grid and is designed to work with the Stream Deck XL console and the Stream Deck Mobile app for iPad.

The setup, installation, and method of use of both products is the same. However, Notation Express XL includes many additional functions that take advantage of the extra buttons.

When applicable, in this guide those instructions will be denoted by this icon: XL

If you are fortunate enough to have both a Stream Deck and a Stream Deck XL, or even the Stream Deck Mobile app on your iPhone, iPad, and a Stream Deck or Stream Deck XL, it is possible to use both products simultaneously to supercharge your workflow even more.




Set up


Setup is really easy.

Important! Notation Express only supports Sibelius Ultimate 2024.3 (and later). Earlier versions of Sibelius are no longer supported. These installation instructions only apply to Sibelius Ultimate 2024.3 (and later).

1. Install the Stream Deck desktop app from Elgato

If you haven't done so already, download and install the Stream Deck desktop app from: https://elgato.com/gaming/download





If you're using the Stream Deck console, connect it to your computer via the USB cable.

Stream Deck Mobile only

If you're using Stream Deck Mobile on iOS or Android, be sure that that your phone/tablet and your PC are on the same wireless network.

Download the mobile app and purchase a subscription if you haven't done so already:

Launch the Stream Deck app on your desktop. Follow the instructions to pair your devices.


2. Install the Notation Express for Sibelius plugin

Don't like reading installation instructions? We understand that you just want to start pushing those shiny buttons right away. It's important to get Notation Express working correctly, though, so if you prefer, please watch this installation video. It's only 3 minutes long!

This section will not apply if you have never installed the Stream Deck plugin before.


If you have an earlier version of the plugin installed, please uninstall it by right-clicking (**Control**-click, on Mac), and selecting **Uninstall...**



⚠ If you don't see this in the Stream Deck desktop app, click this icon to customize which actions your Stream Deck shows:



Select **Custom** and select **Notation Express for Sibelius**, and click **Done**.



Then, uninstall as above, and proceed as follows.


Double-click the Notation Express for Sibelius.streamDeckPlugin.

You will get a message from Stream Deck.




This will install the **Notation Express for Sibelius** plugin in Stream Deck.

To confirm, in the Stream Deck desktop app, you should see **Notation Express for Sibelius** in the **Custom** list.



⚠ If you purchased both Notation Express and Notation Express XL, and/or you wish to install the profile on multiple Stream Decks, you need only install the plugin once.

If you attempt to install it again, you will get a message that the plugin is already installed:




2. Install the Notation Express Stream Deck Profile

Double-click the Notation Express for Sibelius 2024.streamDeckProfile

(XL : Notation Express XL for Sibelius 2024.streamDeckProfile) file from the installation packet you purchased. This will import the Notation Express profile into the Stream Deck desktop app.

In Stream Deck, **Preferences > Profiles** select the **Notation Express for Sibelius 2024** profile, and for **Application:** select **Sibelius** so that Stream Deck will automatically switch to **Notation Express for Sibelius 2024** when Sibelius is in the foreground.



Do this for each device (console or iOS device) you want to use Notation Express with (keep in mind that your purchase only allows one user per purchase).

3. Install the Notation Express supporting files for Sibelius

Quit Sibelius if it is running.

Double-click the **Notation Express for Sibelius - Stream Deck** installer (.pkg on Mac or .exe on Windows).

- Rotation Express for Sibelius Stream Deck.exe
- Notation Express for Sibelius Stream Deck.pkg

If you have purchased Notation Express and Notation Express XL at the same time, you need only run the installer once.

This will install the required Sibelius plug-ins into the appropriate folders on your computer. You're almost done!

4. Set up Sibelius


Launch Sibelius. You must be using Sibelius Ultimate 2024.3 or later.

Open Sibelius's **Preferences**, found in the **File** tab.

In Preferences > Input Devices, you will see Sibelius Connect. Check Allow Sibelius to be remotely controlled by other applications. Do not change the Network port to anything other than 1898.



Click **OK** to exit **Preferences**. Momentarily, you should see a pop-up message on your screen from Sibelius asking to allow to allow the connection from "Notation Express Stream Deck Plugin for Sibelius". Click **Yes**.



That's it! You can now begin using Notation Express.

What's new in Notation Express for Sibelius 2024

Notation Express for Sibelius 2024 has been completely rebuilt. Every button has been reprogrammed to take advantage of Sibelius's ability to receive commands directly from Stream Deck, instead of relying upon a custom keyboard shortcut profile as the intermediary.

Notation Express for Sibelius 2024 adds support for many new features: more than 75 new buttons to Notation Express XL for Sibelius and more than 40 new buttons to Notation Express (15-key) for Sibelius.

Many icons have also been refreshed, and the profile has been re-organized in certain areas.

Rebuilding every button of Notation Express


You may have noticed that earlier versions of Notation Express installed a custom key-board shortcut profile called **Notation Express (user copy)**. In Sibelius 2024 it is no longer necessary to rely on these shortcuts.

This is a major change for the following reasons:

- Reclaim your shortcuts You can now reclaim all of the keyboard shortcuts for your own use, as you like, without them being reserved by Notation Express
- Cross-platform support One Notation Express profile works for both Mac and Windows, so you can use the same profile on both operating systems (no need to purchase separate versions)
- Multi-language support Notation Express is now supported in all languages, so you don't need to switch to English to use it in Sibelius (the icon labels will still only be in English, for now)
- Faster The direct connection to Sibelius makes Notation Express significantly
 more responsive, because it passes commands directly to Sibelius instead of invoking a series of macros that may involve opening and typing into a text area, for
 example
- Background control The direct connection to Sibelius means that you can use
 your Stream Deck to control Sibelius even when another application is running in
 the foreground
- **Expandability** Rebuilding Notation Express in this way has allowed us to add many more buttons; see the very next section for more information

Updating from an earlier version of Notation Express

If you are a customer of Notation Express for Sibelius prior to Sibelius 2024, first of all, thank you!

Notation Express for those versions of Sibelius is no longer officially supported, so we can devote our efforts to making the best of Sibelius 2024 and later.


If you still need to work with Sibelius 2023.x or earlier, you can still use the earlier version(s) of Notation Express for as long as you like.

But, if you use Notation Express for Sibelius 2024, we do recommend that you uninstall earlier versions of the Notation Express for Sibelius profile that you may have.


Here's how to do that.

Delete the earlier Notation Express Stream Deck profile

In Stream Deck, **Preferences > Profiles**, select the Notation Express for Sibelius profile (or any other earlier profile you may have), and click the red "minus" button.



When the warning appears, click **Delete**.




Reset your keyboard shortcuts (only if upgrading from Notation Express for Sibelius 2023 or earlier)

It is not necessary or advised to reset your keyboard shortcuts if you are upgrading from Notation Express for Sibelius 2024 or later, or if you have never used any version of Notation Express for Sibelius before.

In Sibelius, **Preferences > Keyboard Shortcuts > Current feature set:**, you can feel free to change this to **Standard menus and shortcuts**, or any other feature set that you prefer.



There is no harm in leaving the **Notation Express (user copy)** feature set on your computer, but if you would like to delete this profile, click on **Edit Feature Sets...**, choose **Notation Express (user copy)**, and click **Delete**.



A warning will appear:



Be aware: This will delete your Notation Express keyboard shortcuts, as well as any additional custom keyboard shortcuts you may have programmed if you customized this feature set further. If you'd rather not delete those, click **No**; Notation Express for Sibelius 2024 can live happily alongside the existing keyboard shortcuts. You can also choose another feature set without needing to delete the Notation Express feature set.


Otherwise, to delete this feature set, click Yes.

You can freely assign your own custom keyboard shortcuts in Sibelius 2024 without interfering with Notation Express.

Using Notation Express

Using Notation Express is as simple as pushing a button, literally!

All of the top-level buttons are folders that contain commands. The commands are generally self-explanatory, but if you have any questions about how they work or what they do, consult the **Sibelius Reference**.



Certain folders contain subfolders with more commands.

Quick tip!

Many sub-folders are arranged at the same position on the screen as the enclosing folder. For instance, to quickly get to **More View Options**, **Zoom** from the home screen, doubletap on the **View & Options** button.

Certain other actions are organized similarly: Double-tap on **Techniques** to enter **Other Playing Technique**, for instance.

In Notation Express XL, the arrangement is different in certain places. For instance, double-tap on the **Notes** button to bring up **More Notes**; Double-tap on **Text** to get to **Characters & Diacritics**.



The home screen of Notation Express XL, and Page 2 of the home screen of Notation Express, also have quick buttons to the Sibelius Reference (when Sibelius is in use), the official Sibelius help forum, the Notation Express web site, and the Scoring Notes web site.

Third-party tools

Notation Express comes with built-in support for some popular third-party tools, including launching the MIDI plug-ins **Graphical MIDI Tools** and **UltraMix**, and eight plugins that come installed with the **NotePerformer** playback engine.




Purchase of these tools separately is required; the buttons will not do anything if these tools are not installed on your system.

Setting custom articulations

Sibelius allows you to define three custom articulations in your document in addition to the standard ones. To do this, follow the directions in the Sibelius Reference, section **4.22 Articulations**.

Once you define these articulations, you can quickly use them in Notation Express XL. The shortcuts are already programmed for you, but if you like, you can change the title to remind you of the articulation you defined, or even replace the icon with one you design yourself.



Custom trill lines

Buttons for three custom trill lines are included. These will only work if those custom line styles exist in the document. All Scoring Express templates (available separately at **scoringexpress.com**) include these trills. The default house styles for the Norfolk and Lelandia fonts also include these lines.

If you wish to create these lines on your own in a Sibelius document, you must name them exactly as follows, for Notation Express to recognize them:

- Trill with natural
- Trill with flat
- Trill with sharp

Be aware

Where's Key Signature / Time Signature / etc.?

There are a few very basic Sibelius commands not programmed into Notation Express.

For example, the following commands are not programmed into Notation Express and instead can easily be accessed from a computer keyboard:

A-G = note names

K = Key Signature

T = Time Signature

Of course, you can modify the Notation Express profile to suit your needs and add these commands and others if you wish.

XL The Notation Express XL profile includes folders for **Key signatures** and **Time signatures**.

Where's my favorite item/command?

There are hundreds of actions programmed into Notation Express for Sibelius, but the possible permutations available would stretch into the thousands, so many of them are not included.

Of course, you can modify the Notation Express profile to suit your needs and add any commands if you wish.

Can I use my existing keyboard shortcuts with Notation Express?

Yes! Notation Express for Sibelius 2024 takes full advantage of the latest technology and does not rely on Sibelius's keyboard shortcut profiles. So you can program your own key commands to control Sibelius 2024 and they will not interfere with Notation Express.

Localization and program version

Notation Express for Sibelius 2024 works on both Mac and Windows, and in all language setups, with no further configuration necessary. However, on Stream Deck, the button icons and text are only displayed in English, regardless of which language you use in Sibelius or on your system.

Notation Express is built for the latest version of Sibelius Ultimate 2024. It will not work with earlier versions of Sibelius or with Sibelius Artist or Sibelius First.

Troubleshooting

If the connection is lost between Stream Deck and Sibelius, quit and restart the Stream Deck app. If that doesn't work, try disconnecting and reconnecting the Stream Deck to your computer.

As a security measure, Sibelius will display the pop-up asking for your approval to connect at the start of each Sibelius session, and/or when the Stream Deck is connected or re-connected.

Notation Express is built for the latest version of Sibelius Ultimate (2024.3 at this writing). Use with earlier Sibelius versions is not supported.

XL Notation Express XL usage


There are many functions unique to Notation Express XL. Here are some highlights.

XL Copy, paste, and rearrange icons

You'll notice several blank buttons on the home screen and in many of the subfolders. This is a feature, not a bug! This way, you can fully customize your home screen with the most frequently used functions, and you can rotate these in and out depending on your project, without disrupting the core Notation Express XL arrangement.

To do this, in the Stream Deck desktop app, simply select the folder or function you wish to copy, press \mathcal{H} -C on Mac or Ctrl+C on Windows to copy the item(s), and press \mathcal{H} -V on Mac or Ctrl+V on Windows to paste the item(s) to the home screen (or wherever else you like).

For instance, if you are working with lyrics a lot, you might want easy access to those buttons and the **Characters & Diacritics** folder on the home page:




XL Setting custom time signatures

This feature was available on earlier versions of Notation Express XL for Sibelius. We have temporarily removed it, but hope to re-introduce it in a future update.


XL The Notes folder

The **Notes** folder is significantly different in Notation Express XL. Not only does it include the most common functions used when entering notes, it includes the most common articulations.



XL Keypad & Keyboard

The **Keypad & Keyboard** folder includes a full numeric keypad as well as other keys not easily found on a laptop or small keyboard. This can be useful if you need to use these keys but don't have a full-size keyboard handy.



XL Subito dynamic

This feature was available on earlier versions of Notation Express XL for Sibelius. We have temporarily removed it, but hope to re-introduce it in a future update.
